Policy Number 12:

Participating in Activities Under An External IACUC

Scope:

This policy applies to activities (whether teaching and/or research) involving vertebrate animals by representatives of Marian University that are under the oversight of a different institution's IACUC.

Policy Statement:

This policy describes expectations for members of the Marian University community (faculty, staff, or students) who are participating in activities involving vertebrate animals under the oversight of a different institution's IACUC.

Procedure:

- Individuals seeking to participate in activities involving vertebrate animals that are under the oversight of another institution's IACUC must comply with all applicable policies, standards, and procedures of said IACUC. Failure to do so may constitute grounds for formal action by Marian University including but not limited to instituting a professional development plan, mandatory training, prohibition/restriction of certain research activities, and separation from the university.
- The individual is not required to notify the Marian University IACUC of said activities or complete training requirements that pertain to Marian University IACUC protocols. However, training modules and/or other materials may be made available to the individual upon request to the Marian University IACUC Chairperson.
